A selection committee made up of members of the Society asks for nominations, and selects the upcoming years awardee based on established criteria.

The lecturer receives an award of \$25,000, complimentary hotel accommodations, travel reimbursement, and registration to the Society's Annual Meeting. This award was established by Dr. Phillip Frost in 2007.
