



GUIDELINES: REVIEW ARTICLES

A REVIEW ARTICLE is expected to be comprehensive, scholarly, and balanced, presenting an expert curation of the literature in the topic of interest. Authors are encouraged to contact the Editor before submitting reviews for consideration at JIDEditor@sidnet.org.

Review Articles should include:

- 100-word abstract.
- 4,000 words of text (maximum), excluding references.
- A conflict of interest statement.
- Up to 5 figures or diagrams.
- References in *JID* style (alphabetical, with inclusive pages; 6 authors plus et al – for one author, callout in the text should appear as “(Smith, 2012)”; for two authors “(Smith & Jones, 2012)”; for three or more authors “(Smith et al, 2012)”. For more detail see the Information for Authors at www.jidonline.org.
- Review articles should not have supplementary data (but multimedia files are allowed).
- Submit the article to <http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/jid>.
- All articles are peer reviewed prior to acceptance and publication, and some invited articles may ultimately not be accepted for publication.
- *Note: Page charges apply to author-initiated (unsolicited) review articles.*
