

GUIDELINES: REVIEW ARTICLES

A REVIEW ARTICLE is expected to be comprehensive, scholarly, and balanced, presenting an expert curation of the literature in the topic of interest. Authors are encouraged to contact the Editor before submitting reviews for consideration at <u>JIDEditor@sidnet.org</u>.

Review Articles should include:

- 100-word abstract.
- Suggested word limit: 4,000, excluding references.
- Figures: No limit.
- Suggested table limit: 2.
- A conflict of interest statement.
- References in JID style (alphabetical, with inclusive pages; 6 authors plus et al for one author, callout in the text should appear as "(Smith, 2012)"; for two authors "(Smith & Jones, 2012)"; for three or more authors "(Smith et al, 2012)". For more detail see the Information for Authors at www.jidonline.org.
- Submit the article to <u>http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/jid.</u>
- All articles are peer reviewed prior to acceptance and publication, and some invited articles may ultimately not be accepted for publication.
- Note: Page charges apply to author-initiated (unsolicited) review articles.
